Consultant hereby agrees that such information will be kept confidential and will not, without the prior consent of the Company, be disclosed by them, their agents or employees, except as otherwise required by law.

The consultant and the company may agree to enter into a separate finders/consultant agreement for introductions and leads resulting in investment, funding, acquisitions or strategic business relationships, not included within the terms of this agreement.

Term

The term of this Agreement shall commence on _____ for one year with an option to renew. Both parties have the right to terminate this agreement based on 30 days written notice.

Compensation

In full consideration and compensation for the consulting services to be rendered to the Company by the Consultant, the Consultant shall be remunerated as follows:
