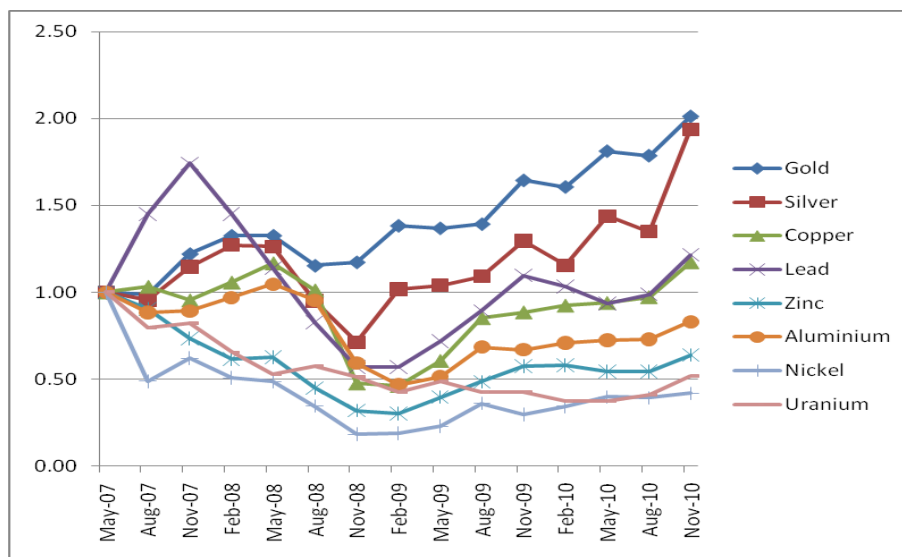

Topic: Commodity Charts

The following chart illustrates the changes that have occurred in the prices of key metal commodities: gold; silver; copper; lead; zinc; aluminium; nickel; and uranium.

The chart shows the relative price changes for each of these commodities beginning in May 2007 and plotted quarterly thereafter.

Gold and silver are the clear winners over this time frame.

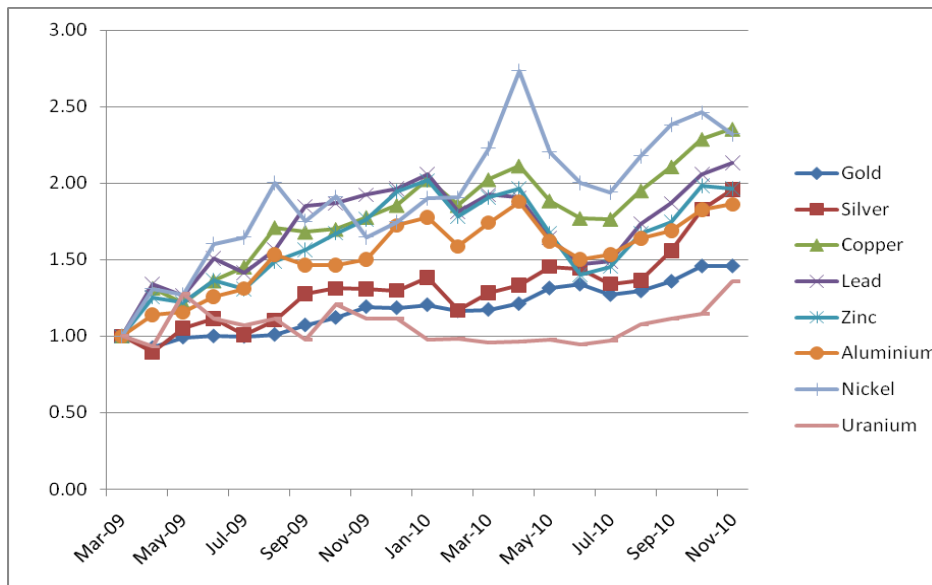


But, let us see what has happened since the March 9, 2009 market lows. The chart on the following page shows a different story.

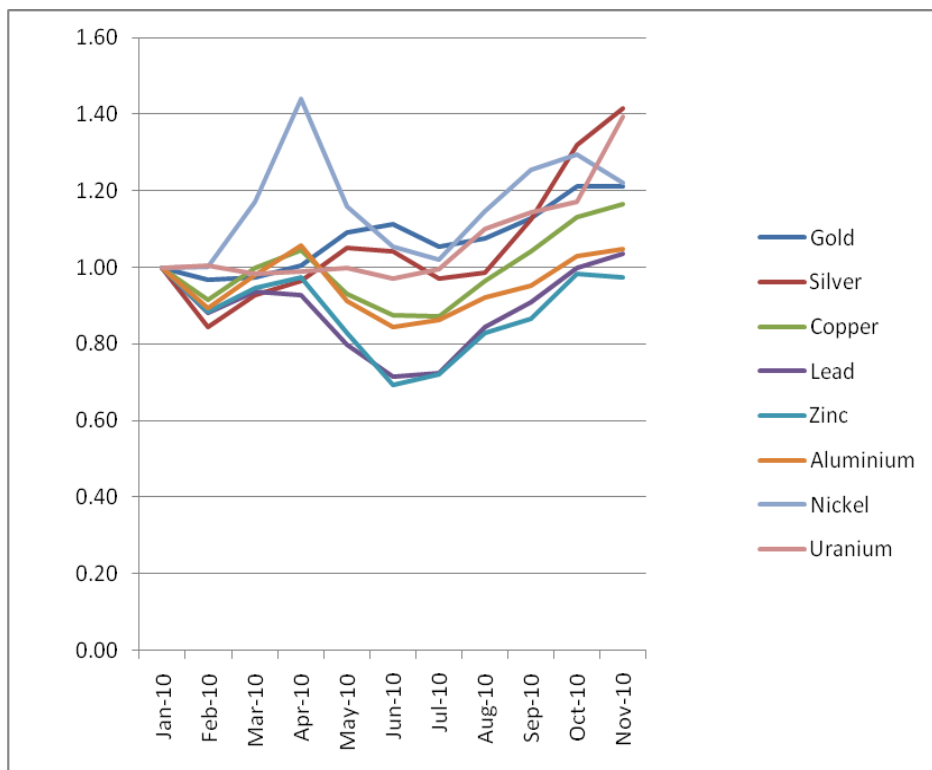
From the March 2009 lows, the leading commodities for price increases are copper and nickel. Gold and uranium bring up the rear.

Great Panther Silver Limited (\$1.83 - November 8, 2010; GPR-TSX-V) (1) Great Panther reported final results from the recently completed 8,815.4-metre surface drill program on the *Topia* mine veins (west-central Durango state in Mexico). A table of *Topia* drilling highlights is contained in Great Panther's November 8 news release. **(2)** On November 10, Great Panther announced financial results for the third quarter ended September 30, with new all-time records in revenue and earnings from mining operations.

Wallbridge Mining Company Limited (\$0.235 - November 8, 2010; WM-TSX/WC7-Frankfurt) Wallbridge and major platinum producer Lonmin Plc have approved C\$1.25 million in funding to explore for platinum and palladium, as well as copper and nickel, on their Sudbury Camp joint venture properties. The funding provides for up to 4,100 metres of diamond drilling and other exploration, to be carried out from October 1, 2010 till September 30, 2011. Lonmin will contribute US\$1.0 million to the funding, while Wallbridge will contribute C\$0.25 million, for a Canadian dollar equivalent of about C\$1.25 million, depending on exchange-rate fluctuations during the budget year.

Augen Gold Corp. (\$0.22 - November 9, 2010; GLD-TSX-V) (1) Augen Gold has completed construction of a corduroy road that will provide access to the newly established camp on the north shore of *Lake Opeepeesway* at the Company's 100%-owned South Swayze property in Ontario. The Company is ready to begin winter drilling. **(2)** Augen announced on November 10 that it has started trenching and sampling in the area of several soil gas hydrocarbon anomalies near *Côté Lake* in the eastern part of the Swayze property.

SLAM Exploration Ltd. (\$0.18 - December 11, 2010; SXL-TSX-V) SLAM has completed the first four holes at its *Silverjack* property in New Brunswick. The Company has intersected sulphide mineralization over core intervals ranging from 0.5 metre to 7.0 metres in all four holes.

Botswana Metals Limited (\$0.15 - November 12, 2010; BML-ASX (Australian)) Botswana confirmed that the Company has intersected more copper and silver mineralization in a flat-lying secondary enriched supergene zone at its *Dibete* discovery in Botswana. The Company is awaiting independent laboratory results to confirm grades.
